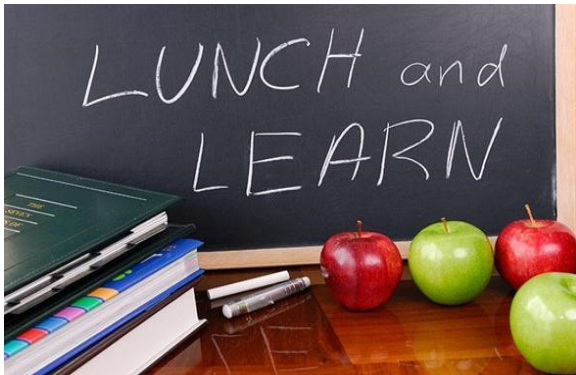

Tourism Season has started, and with that we have changed our hours. We are now open on Saturdays from 10-3.

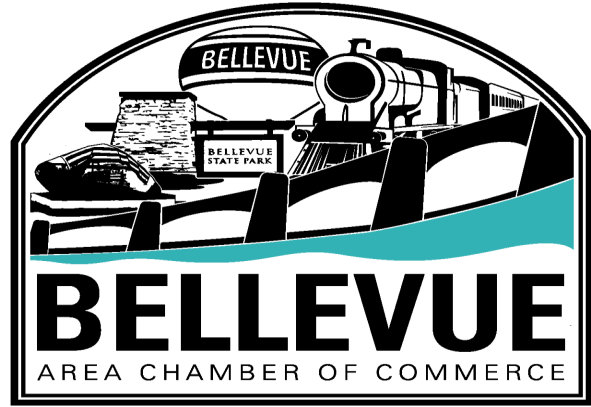
