Regular Session

APPROVAL OF AGENDA

Mayor Roling reviewed the Agenda and declared it approved.

CONSENT AGENDA

Feuerbach moved with a second by Roth to approve the Consent Agenda. Motion carried unanimously.

REAP GRANT

Jackson County Conservation Officer Daryl Parker reviewed the REAP application he completed for the second phase of the bike/walking trail to the north. He needs Council approval and appropriate signatures to complete the application process. Parker is willing to go to Des Moines when the Grant is considered.

Lawson moved with a second by Ernst to approve the REAP Grant Application. Motion carried unanimously.

PART-TIME POLICE OFFICERS

Police Chief Lynn Schwager requested Council approval to post for applications for part-time police officer positions. Currently there are three reserve officers interested in paying their own way for academy training and then working as needed. This would incur no expense for the City. After posting the position for ten days, Chief Schwager will present the applications to the Council.

Roth moved with a second by Lawson to authorize Police Chief Lynn Schwager to post for applications for part-time police officers. Motion carried unanimously.

COMMUNITY CENTER ROOF

IIW Engineer Ron Balmer submitted quotes from Geisler Brothers Co. to replace or repair the roof at the Community Center.

Repair Quote = \$7,000.00

Replace Quote = \$13,700.00

Feuerbach moved with a second by Roth to approve Geisler Brothers Company quote of \$13,700.00 to replace the roof at the Bellevue Community Center. Motion carried unanimously.
